REFERENCE.

1. Whare on Mr. C. Adkin's property, used as depot only, and available for trampers by permission.
2. "Avalanche Clearing," formed by slips destroying bush on right bank of river—an ideal camping place.  
Track cut through bush by Adkin's party up spur leading from "Avalanche Clearing" to top of Mt. Dundas, and joining Girdlestone's route near the timber line.
3. "Park Valley," stated by Mr. Adkin to be a tributary of Waiohineiti and not Otaki as shown.
4. Track overgrown — of use when Waingawa Gorge impassable by flood.
5. Adkin's direct route follows spur to top of divide, then northwards 20 chains along divide before descending steep face to Mangahao River.
